1. Temperature of at least one hundred and one degrees Fahrenheit, as described in rule, in combination with any other sign or symptom of illness;

3. Severe coughing as described in rule;
4. Difficult or rapid breathing;
5. Yellowish skin or eyes;
6. Redness of the eye or eyelid as described in rule;
7. Untreated infected skin patches as described in rule;
8. Unusually dark urine or stool as described in rule;
9. Stiff neck with elevated temperature;
10. Evidence of lice, etc. as described in rule;
11. Sore throat or difficulty in swallowing;
12. Vomiting as described in rule.
