Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the administrator, child care staff, and/or employees of the program did not protect or remove a child from a situation determined to be unsafe, which resulted in a serious incident or injury to a child, as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. Aggressive argument involving adults;
- 2. Staff member(s) did not follow emergency exiting procedures;
- 3. Staff member(s) allowed child(ren) to do something unsafe;
- 4. Staff member(s) did something unsafe;
- 5. Other: Child ran away from the group that was exiting the playground into the parking lot and street.

All program employees must take actions to protect children in care. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
