- 1. Children were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during indoor play and near enough to respond/ reach the children immediately. This could have prevented a parent from disciplining a child that was not his/her own.
- 2. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during outdoor play.
- 3. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member more than once.
- 4. Staff were not physically present in the space and near enough to respond and reach the child(ren) immediately.
