<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number 5 below.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served. (Pineapple served at lunch instead of strawberries)
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a first aid kit onsite.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined first aid kit(s) at the program had missing, or expired, items that are required by appendix A of this rule to be contained in a first aid kit, as noted in number(s) 2, 9, 10, 16, and 17 below:

- 1. The program did not have a first aid kit [onsite, on the vehicle, on a field trip].
- 2. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape. (Beaver)
- 3. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- 4. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- 5. Tweezers.
- 6. Gauze rolled bandage.
- 7. Triangular bandage.
- 8. Rounded end scissors.
- 9. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only). (Bus -Expired)
- 10. A working digital thermometer. (Bus)
- 11. Disposable non-latex gloves.
- 12. A working flashlight.
- 13. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit.

- 14. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.
- 15. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.
- 16. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only). (Bus)
- 17. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only). (Bus)

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the bottle was not prepared appropriately as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. The bottle was not shaken well;
- 2. The temperature of the bottle was not tested before feeding;
- 3. Frozen breast milk was not thawed under cold running water or in the refrigerator;
- 4. Other [ ].
