Allegation: The complainant alleged the program did not provide an accurate daily written record for each infant in care to the parents when picking up the infant each day.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the written record used to document infant routines and activities did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 2 below:

1. A daily written record was not provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis.
2. Food intake was missing.
3. Sleeping patterns was missing.
4. Times and results of diaper changes was missing.
5. Information about daily activities was missing.
