Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

Finding: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was stored where children had access to it, as noted in numbers 1 and 2 below.

1. Bleach. (Unlocked door in toddler room)
2. Cleaning agent. (Under kitchen area sink. The door was open)
3. Fish tank chemicals.
4. Gasoline.
5. Pesticide.
6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.
7. Flammable substance.



8. Windshield washer fluid.
9. Aerosol cans.
10. A lawn mower.
11. A weed trimmer.

Finding: During the inspection, equipment was determined to be unsafe or hazardous to children and in need of repair as noted in numbers 1 and 4 below:

1. The equipment had sharp points or corners; (Broken toy bins (sensory, train and dramatic play)- Preschool)
2. The equipment had splinters;

4. The equipment had loose or rusty parts; (Xylophone- Toddler)
