Allegation: It was alleged that stored soiled disposable diapers were not covered and easily accessible to children.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not storing or laundering soiled diapers or clothing according to the rule, in that the program did not meet the condition indicated in number(s) 6 below.

1. Store for no longer than one day
2. Store in an individual covered container or plastic bag away from children's belongings
3. Kept out of reach of children
4. Store soiled diapers and diapering washcloths laundered by the center in a covered container with sanitizing solution
5. Hold soiled diapers to be commercially laundered for no more than seven days
6. Store soiled disposable diapers in a plastic-lined covered container not easily accessible to children (PS)
7. Discard disposable diapers daily or more frequently as needed to eliminate odor
8. Launder diapers according to manufacturer's guidelines
9. Other []
