- 1. The material had a tear/was worn through (vinyl soft climber in infant 2, red vinyl chair in PreK 1).
- 2. The material was not washable.
- 3. The material was porous.
- 4. The surface was cracked.
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning (tape on red vinyl couch in Infant
- 2, and on blue vinyl couch in PreK 2).
- 6. Other [ ].
