Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Outdoor Equipment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that has openings less than 3 1/2 inches and no more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment on the outdoor play space posed an imminent risk of harm to a child as noted in number 6 below:

- 1. The climber was not anchored.
- 2. The swings were not securely anchored.
- 3. The slide was not securely anchored.
- 4. The climbing rope was not securely anchored at both ends.
- 5. The "S" hooks on the climber were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.
- 6. The "S" hooks on the swings were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.
- 7.The [] had an opening that was greater than three and one-half inches, but less than nine inches. Equipment openings must be less than 3 1/2 inches or more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment. Discontinue the use of this equipment until it has been removed, repaired or replaced. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items or conditions which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 1 and 7 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 5. Stacked chairs.
- 6. Telephone cords.
- 7. Employee purse.
- 8. Diaper bags.
- 9. Television not securely anchored.
- 10. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 11. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 12. Chipping or peeling paint.
- 13. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 14. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 15. A floor surface was unsafe in that [].
- 16. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet.
- 17. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy.
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [].
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to use fall surface material according to manufacturer's guidelines and provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the fall zone under and around equipment designated for climbing, swinging, balancing and sliding did not meet the requirements as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. The fall surface material had not been properly distributed, turned over or raked as needed.
- 2. The fall surface material was not being used according to manufacturer's guidelines for its use as a fall surface.
- 3. Other fall zone does not cover entire hammock.

The program is required to provide adequate fall zones under and around outdoor play equipment at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-10 Health Training

Code: The program is required to meet the health training requirements.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the CCSM or Substitute CCSM was left alone with children and did not have current valid documentation for trainings listed in numbers4 and 10 below:

- 1. First Aid expired training
- 2. First Aid did not have verification of completion of First Aid training
- 3. First Aid documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule
- 4. CPR expired training
- 5. CPR had not taken CPR training
- 6. CPR did not have verification of the completion of CPR training
- 7. CPR training taken did not include all age groups the program serves and developmental levels of all children in care
- 8. CPR documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule
- 9. CPR audiovisual or electronic media training taken by staff did not include an in-person component of the training
- 10. Communicable Disease expired training
- 11. Communicable Disease had not taken CD training
- 12. Communicable Disease did not have verification of the completion of the CD training
- 13. Communicable Disease documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule



- 14. Child Abuse expired training
- 15. Child Abuse had not taken Child Abuse training
- 16. Child Abuse documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule

Correct the violation and submit the documentation of current certification with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in number 16 below:

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information
- 4. Complete parent information
- 5. Complete emergency contact information
- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"
- 10. Emergency transportation information
- 11. Parent/guardian's signature
- 12. Diapering Statement
- 13. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures
- 14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator
- 15. Enrollment form for at least one child was not signed by the administrator
- 16. Other no annual update

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number 1 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed
- 6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
