#### Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the center for a period of one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 2,4 below:

1. No attendance record was being maintained.

- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed. (Bears and Sprout)
- 3. The record did not include the name of at least one child.
- 4. The record did not include the birth date of at least one child. (Sprouts)
- 5. The record did not include the assigned group.
- 6. The record did not include the child's weekly schedule.

7. The record did not include the time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

8. The original attendance record was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide equipment and materials that are easy to clean.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The material had a tear. (Sprout room- Diaper changing pad.)
- 2. The material was not washable.
- 3. The material was porous.
- 4. The surface was cracked.
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and cleaning and sanitizing supplies in a place that is inaccessible to children. School-age children may use cleaning supplies and equipment with adult supervision.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was not used or stored properly as noted in number(s) 12 below:

- 1. Cosmetics were accessible to children in the [ ] area.

- 1. The plan was not posted in each classroom. (Upstairs.)
- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.
- 6. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [ ].

3. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not updated changes to positions or roles within five calendar days of the change.

4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.

5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.

6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.

7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.

Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.



- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.
