Complaint Allegations

Code: The program is required to ensure the driver follows all safety precautions while transporting children in care.

Allegation: Complainant alleges that the program did not follow the ODJFS Child Care Transportation Training.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that while transporting children, the driver failed to follow safety precautions, as indicated in number 5 below:

- 1. An adult was permitted to stand in a moving vehicle.
- 2. Children were permitted to stand in a moving vehicle.
- 3. Children did not safely board or exit the vehicle in a low traffic area.
- 4. The person driving was talking on a cell phone while the vehicle was moving.
- 5. Other: Driver failed to yield to children in a cross walk at the Elementary School.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes assurance that these safety guidelines will be met when children are transported, and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
