<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a medication, Epipen was within the reach of children in the the C room. All medications must be stored out of the reach of children. Create procedures that assure medications will always be inaccessible to children. Provide staff training.
