Complaint Allegations

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Ratio

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

Allegation: The complainant alleged the program is not maintaining required staff/child ratios.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, a ratio of 1 child care staff member(s) for 17 children was determined to have occurred for the Penguins group when the situation in number(s) 6 below occurred:

1. A child care staff member stepped out of the room.
2. A child care staff member had not arrived at work on time.
3. Children were present who were not scheduled to be there.
4. A child care staff member was unable to work.
5. A child was injured in that group.
6. Children arrived in the group before a second staff member was scheduled to arrive with the group.
7. Two groups were combined, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.
8. A child was transitioning to the next older age group, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.
9. Ratio was doubled for more than two hours while children were napping.
10. Ratio was doubled while children were napping for a group that included at least one infant.
11. Ratio was doubled while children were napping and there were not enough staff members in the building to meet staff/child ratio.
12. Ratio was doubled in the school age group to allow access to the program, however, the program does not serve only school age children.
13. Both child care staff members did not have a working communication device when one staff member left the group to allow access to the school age only program.
14. The child care staff member did not return to the group after allowing access to the school age only program.

Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Group Size

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate group size for each group of children served.

Allegation: The complainant alleged group size limitations were not maintained.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, group size limitations were not maintained for the group of Ducklings as it was determined there were 13 children grouped together. The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per Child Care Staff Member. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain:05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-12-16 Management of Communicable Disease

Code: The program is required to isolate and/or discharge any child demonstrating symptoms listed in rule.

Allegation: The complainant alleged that a child was not isolated or discharged for demonstrating symptoms of a communicable disease.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child was not isolated or discharged for demonstrating symptom(s) listed on appendix B of this rule as noted in number 6 below:

1. Temperature of at least one hundred and one degrees Fahrenheit (one hundred degrees Fahrenheit if taken axillary), when in combination with any other sign or symptom of illness
2. Diarrhea as described in rule
3. Severe coughing as described in rule
4. Difficult or rapid breathing
5. Yellowish skin or eyes
6. Redness of the eye or eyelid as described in rule
7. Untreated infected skin patches as described in rule
8. Unusually dark urine or stool as described in rule
9. Stiff neck with elevated temperature
10. Evidence of lice, etc. as described in rule
11. Sore throat or difficulty in swallowing
12. Vomiting as described in rule
