Findings: In review of the records, it was determined that a JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report For Child Care" form was missing information as noted in number(s) 11 below:

- 1. Program information (program name, number, address);
- 2. Child's name;
- 3. Child's birth date;
- 4. Name of person(s) responsible for the child at the time of the incident;
- 5. Number of children present in the group at the time of the incident;
- 6. Date and/or time of the incident;
- 7. Whether or not parents were contacted;
- 8. Complete summary of the incident;
- 9. Accurate summary of the incident;
- 10. Name and/or signature of the person completing the form;
- 11. Other: On the completed JFS 1299 in question, the program administrator indicated that the parent was contacted about the incident. The administrator had attempted to call the parent, and had left a voice mail with the pertinent information, however, later came to realize that she had dialed the wrong phone number and left the message with an unknown person, making the information recorded on the JFS 1299 inaccurate.
