Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirement for a designee during the administrator's absence as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. A child care staff member had not been designated as the person in charge. (The person appointed as the designee did not know that she was to be the designee in the administrator's absence)
- 2. The child care staff member designated as the person in charge was not at least 18 years of age.
- 3. The child care staff member designated as the person in charge was not on the premises during the administrator's absence.
