**Findings:** During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the requirements for bottle feeding as noted in number 3 below:

1. A bottle was propped for an infant feeding.
2. An infant was placed in a crib with a bottle.
3. An infant was not held or fed sitting up for bottle feedings.

Provide staff training. Submit the program’s corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
