<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition and must implement and/or follow instructions on the plan. The program is required to have staff trained to perform the procedures on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" present at the program when the child requiring the procedure is onsite. Only staff who have been trained shall be permitted to perform the procedures listed on the JFS 01236.



<u>Finding</u>: In review of the children's records, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for caring for at least one child, indicated on the Children Records Review, with a condition that requires a JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" as noted in number(s) 11 & 14 below:

- 15. Symptoms that require staff to administer medication/medical food were missing or not attached.
- 16. Specific instructions to administer the medication/medical food were missing or not attached.
- 17. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing or not attached.
- 18. Physician's signature was missing or not attached.
- 19. The date of the physician's signature was missing or not attached.
