Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. - 16. Child Abuse documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule

- 4. The time period to administer medication on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.
- 5. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.
- 6. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication or medical food.
- 7. The prescription label was not current.
