Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant was placed in a crib with the following suffocation or strangulation hazard , Bib. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
