<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: the mop was being stored in the preschool restroom. A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.
