Code: The program is required to allow the Department access to the program.

Findings: During the inspection or complaint investigation, Department staff were denied access by the program, in that Provider has not allowed Investigator in the home and has reached out to their HPS but has not contacted Investigator back after emails, phone calls and visits. Rule 5180:2-13-03 requires the program to notify parents when a serious risk non-compliance is cited. The notification must inform parents of the serious risk non-compliance and include the Department of Children and Youth website and location of further information regarding the determination. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
