Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing potentially hazardous items, toxic substances, and outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it as noted in number(s) 1 and 2 below. Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined the program did not protect children from an unsafe item or condition or equipment due to the following number(s) 5 below:

- 1. Pull cord(s) on the window blind(s).
- 2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 3. Stacked tables.
- 4. Folding tables.
- 5. Matches and/or a lighter.

- 7. Live wires.
- 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
- 9. Asbestos.

- 14. A crockpot used to heat bottles.
- 15. Immediate access to a knife.

- 17. Marijuana was accessible to children.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-09 Background Checks

Code: The program is required to receive a preliminary approval from ODJFS prior to allowing an individual to engage in assigned duties or be near children.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks did not meet the requirements of the rule for the person(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The request for a background check for child care was not submitted in the OPR.
- 2. The fingerprints were not submitted electronically according to the process established by BCI.
- 3. The individual(s) had engaged in assigned duties or were near children and preliminary approval from ODJFS was not on file.
- 4. Background checks were not updated every five years.

Rule: 5180:2-13-04 Fire Safety for Type B Homes

Code: The program is required to have all electrical connections in junction boxes properly covered.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the electrical connections in the junction box in the following rooms were not properly covered in utility room. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to provide a smoke free environment during operating hours, ensure smoking is not seen by children, post a "No Smoking Sign" by the main entrance, provide notification to parents if smoking occurs on the premises outside of operating hours, and refrain from exposing children to smoking paraphernalia.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not maintaining a smoke free environment, as noted in the number(s) below: 5

- 1. The program did not provide a smoke free environment for children during the hours of child care in that 5
- 2. An individual left the home to smoke, however, this smoking occurred in an area within view of the children.
- 3. A "No Smoking" sign was not displayed in a conspicuous place at the main entrance.
- 4. Smoking had occurred in the program or vehicle during hours the program was not in operation; however, parents had not been given written notice of this.
- 5. Children had access and/or were exposed to smoking paraphernalia in that [cigarettes/cigars/pipe butts/ashes/chewing or smokeless tobacco/electronic cigarettes/vaporizers/bong] was/were observed in view of children.
- 6. Other [].

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental and General Emergency Plan" were not followed as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The plan was not posted on each level of the home used for child care.
- 2. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 3. The location of the first aid kit, fire extinguisher and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 4. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency and police department were not complete.
- 5. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 6. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed i the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 7. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 8. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Communicable Diseases

Code: The program is required to post the Ohio Communicable Disease Chart in a noticeable area.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the Ohio Communicable Disease Chart was not posted as required, as indicated in the number(s) 3 below:

- 1. In a location readily available to provider, child care staff members, employees, and residents;
- 2. The chart was not posted.
- 3. The posted chart was not the current version and the Child Care Manual Procedural Letter No. 159 was not posted next to the chart.
- 4. The posted chart was not displayed in the size available in the ODJFS forms central to be easily read.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that requirements for written permission from the parent/guardian for a field trip or routine trip were not met as listed in number(s) 3 below:

- 1. Written parental permission was not secured for field trips and/or routine trips off the premises.
- 2. The written permission was missing the child's name.
- 3. The written permission was missing the date(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
- 4. The written permission was missing the destination(s) of the trip(s).
- 5. The written permission was missing the departure and return time(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
- 6. The written permission was missing the signature of the parent.
- 7. The written permission was missing the date on which the permission was signed.
- 8. The written permission was missing a statement notifying parents how their child will be transported.
- 9. Permission forms for routine trips were not being updated annually.
- 10. Written parental permission forms for field trips and/or routine trips were not being maintained on file for at least one year from the date of the trip.
