Complaint Allegations

Allegation: Chemicals (aerosols and cleaning agents) were observed at a SUTQ visit in reach of children.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it as noted in number 2 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in the home.
