Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child was left unattended and not supervised, in that the provider stated when answering the door that she was not open for care due to a medical appointment later in the day. The provider's hours were posted and there was not a sign posted stating the closure. We discussed the complaint allegations on the porch and then entered the home and a child four years old was found to be inside and was not within sight or hearing while the discussion was taking place on the front porch.
