Findings: In review of records, it was determined the provider did not have current valid documentation for training(s) listed in numbers 1,4, and 14 below:

- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of
- conscience, including religious convictions
