#### Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item was stored where children had access to it as noted in number 6 below. The potentially hazardous item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children on a shelf in the patio leading to the outside play area.

1. Bleach.
2. Cleaning agent.
3. Fish tank chemicals.
4. Gasoline.
5. Pesticide.
6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.
7. Flammable substance.
8. Windshield washer fluid.
9. Aerosol cans.
10. A lawn mower.
11. A weed trimmer.
12. Hedge trimmers.
13. A snow blower.
14. Other potentially hazardous substance, equipment or machinery: [ ]. Provide staff training.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous item is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number 11 below:

1. Cosmetics
2. Disinfecting wipes
3. Fish food
4. Hand lotion
5. Hand sanitizer (for children under 24 months).
6. Laundry detergent
7. Powder dish washing soap
8. Paint cans
9. White out
10. Potting soil
11. Swiffer wet jet

The potentially hazardous substance was determined to be accessible to children in the following area: kitchen. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children in care from items and conditions that threaten their health, safety, and well being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any item which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 12 below:

1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop;



2. Telephone cords;
3. Electrical/Extension cords attached to an object that would likely result in a severe injury if pulled;
4. Stacked chairs;
5. Employee(s) purse(s);
6. Diaper bags;
7. Television not securely anchored;
8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
9. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
10. Chipping or peeling paint;
11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture: [ ];
12. Candle burning in the living room.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean Environment and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an unsanitary condition, as noted in the following number 4 below, was in the program bathroom:

1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet tissue.
3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
6. The toilet was not flushed.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.
9. Other [ ].

The restroom must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program staff is required to protect the children from hazardous conditions in the outdoor play area.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in numbers 10 and 11 below:

1. There was broken glass.
2. There were tall weeds.
3. There was poison ivy.
4. There were protruding bolts.
5. There were tree branches.
6. There was mold visible.
7. The sandbox was contaminated.
8. There were thistles with pricklers.
9. There were bird droppings.
10. Water hose near the front door.
11. Linked chain at the end of the walkway to the outdoor area.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/31/2021

**Domain: 05 Health & Safety**

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Requirements

Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item numbers 1 and 2 below:

1. Monthly fire drills
2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September)
3. Quarterly emergency/lockdown drills.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-13-09 Background Checks

Code: The program is required to have the applicable JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" on file.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background check requirements had not been followed, for the individual listed on the Employee Record Chart, as noted in number 4 below:



1. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" the program received from the Department was not on file and the individual was not left alone with children.
  2. The JFS 01177 "Individual Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was on file instead of the JFS 01176.
  3. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.
  4. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background check Review for Child Care" was not on file at the program, but was on file at the county agency and the individual is eligible.
- Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the correct form is now on file, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Professional Development

Code: The program staff is required to complete at least six clock hours of training annually.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the provider indicated on the Employee Record Chart did not meet the annual professional development requirement as noted in number 1.

1. The provider had not completed at least 6 hours of professional development.
2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.
3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.
4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.
5. Other [ ].
