#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health,

safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined a kitchen knife was found to be accessible in a kitchen drawer.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a continuous fence in good condition, or natural barrier, that ensured children were not



able to leave the playground area. The fence or natural barrier was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground.

Discontinue use of the playground and provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a continuous fence or natural barrier and protected from other hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Low Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5180:2-13-03 Inspection Requirements

Code: The program is required to respond to all non-compliances by the date noted in the inspection report.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program had not responded to the non-compliances addressed in the inspection report dated 10/8/2024. The rule requires the program complete and submit a corrective action plan in OCLQS to address non-compliances detailed in written inspection reports within the timeframe outlined in the report. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that current and future corrective action plans will be submitted timely, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-18 Attendance

Code: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is

also required to retain the original attendance record at the program for a period of one year.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined attendance had not been documented upon arrival of the child to the daycare. Attendance must be documented upon arrival and departure of children.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental and General Emergency Plan" was not completed. Phone numbers were missing for emergency departments on page one.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" was not completed. The square in bottom right did not have information filled out. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to post the current menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu was not posted.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan

Code: The program is required to have a completed emergency preparedness and response plan.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written emergency preparedness and response plan was not the most current version (2024).

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes the missing information, if applicable, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that routine trip forms were not completed for each child for walking.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to maintain the required liability insurance or have a completed JFS 01933

"Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" on file for each child in care.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the provider did not have a completed JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" completed for Ra'ziah and Zyaire. Correct the violation and submit proof of insurance with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/02/2025

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statement and vaccination records was not on file, as required, for Nyelle Williams.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/02/2025

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care" was not compliant for Zyaire. A question on page 2 was not answered and the form had not been updated by provider and parent annually on the last page.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13 Written Policies and Procedures

Code: The provider is required to create, maintain, and implement the policies and procedures outlined in

appendix C and D of this rule.



Findings: It was determined, the provider was not responsible for creating, maintaining or implementing the policies and procedures. Please complete the new handbook which is form JFS 1312.
