Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 22 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 5. Stacked chairs.
- 6. Telephone cords.
- 7. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 8. Diaper bags.
- 9. Television not securely anchored.
- 10. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 11. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 12. Chipping or peeling paint.
- 13. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 14. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 15. A floor surface was unsafe in that [].
- 16. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet.
- 17. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy.
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [ ].
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [ ].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 22. Other. During inspection it was observed that a small food processor, with blade attached, was in unlocked cupboard within reach.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space. The outdoor play space must provide 60 square foot per child using the space at one time.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor play space did not meet the requirements in rule, as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The outdoor play area did not provide 60 square feet per child using the space at one time.
- 2. The program does not have an outdoor play space.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule. During inspection it was observed that the FCC Provider was using the front porch as a temporary outdoor space due to foot injury. Informed FCC Provider that any new space needs submitted in OCLQS for approval before use.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review form were not updated, as required by this rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule. During inspection, it was observed that form JFS 01218, Basic Infant Information for childcare was incomplete.
