Rule: 5101:2-13-14 Vehicle Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all children under 12 years of age ride in the back seats of the vehicle.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not follow regulations and/or safety precautions when children were transported as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Seat belts were not used by children
- 2. Child restraint systems were not used.
- 3. Children were riding in seats that were not securely anchored.
- 4. More than one child was strapped in a seat belt.
- 5. A child under the age of twelve years old rode in the front seat of the vehicle.
- 6. At least one child or adult was standing or sitting on the floor in a moving vehicle, in that [].

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit on the vehicle/ on a field trip as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit(s) were missing the item(s) or the item(s) were not replaced after use, when expired or damaged listed in number(s) 5,7,8,9,11,13,14,15,16 below:

- 1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;
- 2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze

squares in assorted sizes;

- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- 5. Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors;
- 8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;
- 12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
- 13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
- 14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
- 15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
- 16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).



Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
