Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following number

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet tissue.
- 3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children (beside the toilet in the restroom).
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children (beside the toilet in the restroom).
- 6. The toilet was not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit onsite as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit was missing the item or the item were not replaced after use and/or expired listed in number 13 below:

- 1. One roll of first-aid tape;
- 2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze;
- squares in assorted sizes;
- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- 5. Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors;

8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);

- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;

12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;

13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids; (Added items onsite.)

14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;

15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);

16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
