#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.



Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number(s) 2, 16, and 23 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers;
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop;

3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care;

- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled;
- 5. Stacked chairs;
- 6. Telephone cords;
- 7. Stacked chairs;
- 8. Employee(s) purse(s);
- 9. Diaper bags;
- 10. Television not securely anchored;
- 11. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
- 12. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
- 13. Chipping or peeling paint;
- 14. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing;
- 15. An area rug presented a tripping hazard;

16. A floor surface was unsafe in that cooking oil and two bottles were on stirs going down to the basement daycare area;

- 17. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet;
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy;
- 19. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [ ];
- 20. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [ ];
- 21. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 22. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 23. Other batteries and screws in kitchen cabinet accessible to children.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to direct handles of pots and pans inward to make inaccessible to children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the handles of the pots or pans on the stove were not directed inward and inaccessible to children in care. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program staff and residents are required to wash their hands at the appropriate times as outlined in rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the handwashing requirements were not being followed by the provider, program staff, residents, or a child in that children didn't wash hands when leaving daycare.
