- 7. Live wires.
- 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
- 9. Asbestos.

- 14. A crockpot used to heat bottles.

- 17. Marijuana was accessible to children.
- 18. Other Shaving razor in shower in first floor restroom children in care use.
