Code: The program is required to have all outlets and surge protectors covered.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the outlet on the exterior wall in the outdoor space did not have a childproof receptacle cover. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to have a daily schedule posted in a visible place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the daily schedule was not posted in the program. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit onsite as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit was missing the item listed in number 8 below:

- 1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;
- 2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze

squares in assorted sizes;

- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors:
- 8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;
- 12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
- 13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
- 14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
- 15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
- 16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).



Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Fluid Milk

Code: The program is required to have written documentation from a licensed physician if child is to be served something other than the required fluid milk.

Findings: During this inspection, it was observed that there was no documentation from a licensed physician or parent as required by the rule, when children between 12 and 24 months of age were served anything other than whole homogenized Vitamin D fortified fluid milk. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to have policies and procedures for all items listed in this rule.

Findings: On the day of the inspection, the program's written policies and procedures provided to the parents/guardians and employees was missing item numbers 3 and 6 below:

- 10. Programs shall have a policy in place describing supports for onsite breastfeeding or pumping for mothers who wish to do so (if the program serves infants or toddlers).

Provider Policies and Procedures

- 11. Enrollment including required enrollment information.
- 12. Care of children without immunizations.

- 13. Attendance including procedures for arrival and departure, the program's absent day policy, releasing child to persons other than the parent, releasing a child according to a custody agreement and follow up when a child scheduled to arrive from another program or activity does not arrive.
- 14. Supervision and child guidance.
- 15. Parent provided food and provider dietary policy, if applicable. If all of the food is parent provided, the policy shall also include if the provider supplements food when the parent does not provide sufficient food for the day.
- 16. Management of illness including isolation precautions, symptoms for discharge and return, notification of parent of ill child and whether or not the provider will care for sick children.
- 17. Summary of procedures taken in the event of an emergency, serious illness or injury.
- 18. Administration of medication including food supplements, modified diets and whether school age children are permitted to carry their own medication and ointments.
- 19. Transportation for trips and emergencies.
- 20. Water activities/swimming.
- 21. Infant care, if applicable, including frequency of diaper checks.
- 22. Napping and Resting.
- 23. Evening and overnight care, if applicable.
- 24. Policy on operation and/or closing due to weather, school delays or closings and any other factors.
- 25. Policy on the provider using a substitute or child care staff member pursuant to 5101:2-13-08 of the Administrative Code for sick days, vacations or other time off.
- 26. Policy on when the provider will require dis enrollment of a child
- 27. Procedure for parents or employees to follow when needing assistance in resolving problems related to the family child care home.
- 28. Policy on whether or not the provider will provide child care services to children whose parents refuse to grant consent for transportation to the source of emergency treatment.
- 29. Policy on whether the program conducts formal assessments on enrolled children and if the Enrollment including required enrollment information.
