Rule: 5180:2-13-25 Medication Requirements

Code: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined medication was in the reach of children. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items or conditions which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following numbers 1 and 22 below:

1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers: the outlet behind the couch and the outlet in the bathroom were not covered
22. Other: having the plastic totes stacked no more than 2-high on the shelf in the playroom is acceptable, but there were additional toys stacked on the totes - making the stacks higher overall - that are a hazard. Relocate the toys or secure them in some way, such as using netting or straps, or put the toys directly on the shelf so they are sitting on a secured surface.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that requirements for written permission from the parent/guardian for a field trip or routine trip were not met as listed in number 1 below:

1. Written parental permission was not secured for field trips and/or routine trips off the premises: for child K. M.

2. The provider had not created or updated the program's organizational dashboard in the OPR: hours present at the program were not filled out for the provider and residents

10. The program's organizational dashboard in the OPR was not updated within five calendar days of a change in residency for at least one resident over the age of eighteen: resident over the age of 18 who moved out is still associated to the program
