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Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5180-37:04 Mixed age group size

Code: This rule requires the maximum number of children per preschool staff member to be determined by the age of the youngest child in the group. When no more than one child, thirty months of age or older, receives care in a group in which all the other children are in the next older age group, the maximum number of children per preschool staff member and maximum group size requirements of the older age group established in this rule shall apply.

Findings: During the inspection, the maximum group size per staff member exceeded requirements for the youngest child in a mixed age group class in rooms 4 and 6.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/22/2025

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180-37:06 Protective Mats

Code: This rule requires that protective mats be placed under climbers.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that protective mats not placed under climbers.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/22/2025

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Required background checks

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to meet the requirements as prescribed in section 3301.541 of the Revised Code and if applicable, rehabilitation criteria as described in rules 3301-20-01 and 3301-20-03 of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have evidence of criminal background checks that meet the requirements.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/22/2025

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Background check updates

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Code: This rule requires a director and preschool staff member to provide evidence of criminal record checks and five-year updates that meet the requirements as prescribed in section?3301.541?of the Revised Code and if applicable, rehabilitation criteria as described in rules?3301-20-01?and?3301-20-03?of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, background checks were not updated every five years.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/22/2025

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180-37:05 Center cleaning and sanitizing

Code: This rule requires that the center be cleaned daily and kept in a sanitary condition at all times. Cleaning and sanitizing is not to take place while rooms are occupied by children, except for general cleanup activities such as sweeping, vacuuming, mopping and wiping off tables which are part of the daily routine.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that the center is not cleaned daily and kept in a sanitary condition at all times. Toilets had not been flushed after use.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5180-37:09 Menus

Code: This rule requires the program to post all menus for meals and snacks served by the program in a conspicuous place and any substitute foods should be from the same food group and recorded on the day of the substitution.

Findings: During the inspection, current menus for the week were not posted in a conspicuous place for all meals and snacks.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5180-37:07 Medical and dental emergency procedure posting

Code: This rule requires posting medical and dental emergency procedures in each preschool classroom and by each telephone.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that medical and dental emergency procedures were not posted in each toddler and preschool classroom and by each telephone.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5180-37:07 Emergency procedure postings and records

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Code: This rule requires posting procedures for emergency situations, including fire drills, rapid dismissals and tornado drills and keeping records of such drills or dismissals.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that procedures for emergency situations were not posted in all rooms.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5180-37:07 Emergency numbers posting

Code: This rule requires posting emergency numbers by each telephone.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that emergency numbers were not posted by each telephone.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5180-37:03 Daily Schedule

Code: HB and O

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the daily schedule for each age group was not posted in each room.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180-37:12 Soiled diapers storage/laundering

Code: This rule requires storage and laundering of soiled diapers to be handled in accordance with the following methods:(1) Diapers or clothing soiled with fecal matter and sent home with a child need not be rinsed at the program facility, but may be placed directly into a container that can be sanitized or bag, sealed tightly, stored away from the rest of the child's belongings and out of the reach of children.(2) Soiled diapers to be disposed of or cleaned by the program shall be placed in a common plastic-lined covered container which shall be emptied, cleaned, and disinfected with an appropriate germicidal agent daily or more frequently as needed. Diapers to be laundered at the program facility should be stored in an appropriate germicidal solution until laundered.(3) Soiled diapers to be commercially laundered shall be held for pickup for laundering for no longer than seven days (4) Diapers to be laundered at home or by the program shall be held for laundering for no longer than one day.(5) Soiled disposable diapers shall be discarded daily.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that soiled diapers were not properly disposed. The lid to a container for soiled diapers was not closed.

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Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff Medical statement

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to have evidence of a signed medical statement on or before the first day of employment.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used to count in ratio did not have evidence of a signed medical statement on or before the first day of employment.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff with required health and safety trainings

Code: This rule requires the program to ensure the following each staff member has completed and is current with an approved course for age-appropriate first aid and CPR in accordance with rule 5101:2-12-10 of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, at least one person onsite does not have a current age appropriate course in CPR from an approved provider.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff with required health and safety trainings

Code: This rule requires the program to ensure each staff member has completed and is current with an approved course for age-appropriate first aid and CPR in accordance with rule?5101:2-12-10?of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, at least one person onsite does not have a current age appropriate course in first aid from an approved provider.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Licensed staff in-service requirement

Code: This rule requires preschool staff members licensed by the department to complete ten annual clock hours, which may be part of the professional development plan in accordance with Chapter 3301-24 of the Administrative Code. Annual completion refers to the school year, from July first to June thirtieth.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, preschool staff licensed by the department did not have evidence of ten in-service hours annually.

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Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff Medical statement

Code: This rule requires a new staff member who meets the criteria to complete a tuberculosis test prior to employment.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, a staff member who meets specific criteria to complete a tuberculosis test did not have the documentation on file.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Non-guilty non-conviction statement

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to have a signed non-guilty non-conviction statement on a prescribed form signed annually.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have a non-guilty non-conviction statement on file or signed annually.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Orientation training

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to have an orientation training as prescribed by the department completed within thirty days of the individuals start date.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have documentation of the required orientation training prescribed by the department completed within thirty days of the start date.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff minimum requirements

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in the ratio is obligated to have evidence that they have a high school diploma, GED or high school equivalency.

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Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have documentation of a high school diploma or equivalent on file and available for review.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Annual in-service requirements

Code: This rule requires Annual in-service training be taken from July first to June thirtieth, or every twelve months from the date of hire for staff employed after the school year begins.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, in-service hours were not obtained during the school year as defined by rule from July first through June thirtieth.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180-37:04 Individuals used in ratio

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in the ratio is obligated to have required documentation on file.

Findings: During the inspection and a review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have documentation to meet requirements.
