**Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff/child ratio maintained at all times

Code: This rule requires the preschool staff member/child ratio to be maintained at all times and sufficient individuals must be physically present with the children in accordance with section 3301.56 of the Revised Code.

Findings: During the inspection, sufficient individuals were not physically present with children leaving four toddlers unsupervised.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/15/2026

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5180-37:06 Cleaning and sanitizing supplies

Code: This rule requires that cleaning and sanitizing supplies shall be stored in a space that is inaccessible to children. Cleaning agents, aerosol cans and all other chemical substances are to be stored in a designated area in their original containers and/or clearly labeled.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that cleaning and sanitizing supplies stored in a space, on top of a shelf in a restroom, that were accessible to children.

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5180-37:06 Protective Mats

Code: This rule requires that protective mats be placed under climbers.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that protective mats not placed under climbers, trampolines and rocking boats.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Required background checks

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to meet the requirements as prescribed in section 3301.541 of the Revised

Code and if applicable, rehabilitation criteria as described in rules 3301-20-01 and 3301-20-03 of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have evidence of criminal background checks that meet the requirements.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/15/2026

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Background check updates

Code: This rule requires a director and preschool staff member to provide evidence of criminal record checks and five-year updates that meet the requirements as prescribed in section 3301.541 of the Revised Code and if applicable, rehabilitation criteria as described in rules 3301-20-01 and 3301-20-03 of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, background checks were not updated every five years.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/15/2026

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Substitute requirements

Code: This rule requires a substitute to meet the requirements as prescribed in section 3301.541 of the Revised Code and if applicable, rehabilitation criteria as described in rules 3301-20-01 and 3301-20-03 of the Administrative Code

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, a substitute did not have evidence of criminal background checks that meet the requirements.

**Domain: 10 Written Policies & Procedures**

Rule: 5180-37:07 Written medication policy requirements

Code: This rule requires medication to be administered with policies in place that assure child information is gathered and health professional instructions are followed

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that one or more of the following requirements were not met:

- Child's information, medication name, or dosage information was missing and/or parent signature was missing.
- Medication was not in original container or the container from which it was dispensed
- Medication was expired.

**Low Risk Non-Compliances**

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5180-37:06 Safe and sanitary equipment and materials

Code: This rule requires that furniture and equipment meet safety and sanitation requirements.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that storage of equipment does not meet safety and sanitation requirements. A paper cutter was stored within the reach of the children in a classroom.

**Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5180-37:02 Written compliance report posted

Code: This rule requires that the most recent written compliance report be posted.

Findings: During the inspection it was observed the most recent written compliance report was not posted.

**Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5180-37:09 Menus

Code: This rule requires the program to post all menus for meals and snacks served by the program in a conspicuous place and any substitute foods should be from the same food group and recorded on the day of the substitution.

Findings: During the inspection, current menus for the week were not posted in a conspicuous place for all meals and snacks served.

**Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5180-37:07 Medical and dental emergency procedure posting

Code: This rule requires posting medical and dental emergency procedures in each preschool classroom and by each telephone.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that medical and dental emergency procedures were not posted in each preschool classroom and by each telephone.

**Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5180-37:07 Emergency numbers posting

Code: This rule requires posting emergency numbers by each telephone.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that emergency numbers were not posted by each telephone.

**Domain: 05 Health & Safety**

Rule: 5180-37:07 Handwashing and disposable towels or air hand dryer available

Code: This rule requires that all preschool staff members wash their hands with soap and running water after each diaper change, or after assisting a child with toileting; after cleaning; after toileting; before preparing or eating food; before feeding any child; and when hands have been in contact with nasal or mucous secretions. Disposable towels or an air hand dryer shall be available at all times.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that all preschool staff members did not wash their hands with soap and running water after each diaper change, or after assisting a child with toileting; after cleaning; after toileting; before preparing or eating food; before feeding any child; and when hands have been in contact with nasal or mucous secretions.

**Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5180-37:12 Diapering requirements

Code: This rule requires if diapers are to be changed in a crib or at a central changing station, there shall be some separation material between the child and the changing surface. The material shall be discarded and replaced after each change. If the crib bedding becomes wet or soiled during the diaper change, it is to be replaced with clean bedding.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed separation material was not used.

**Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5180-37:12 Soiled diapers storage/laundrying

Code: This rule requires storage and laundrying of soiled diapers to be handled in accordance with the following methods:(1) Diapers or clothing soiled with fecal matter and sent home with a child need not be rinsed at the program facility, but may be placed directly into a container that can be sanitized or bag, sealed tightly, stored away from the rest of the child's belongings and out of the reach of children.(2) Soiled diapers to be disposed of or cleaned by the program shall be placed in a common plastic-lined covered container which shall be emptied, cleaned, and disinfected with an appropriate germicidal agent daily or more frequently as needed. Diapers to be laundryed at the program facility should be stored in an appropriate germicidal solution until laundryed.(3) Soiled diapers to be commercially laundryed shall be held for pickup for laundrying for no longer than seven days (4) Diapers to be laundryed at home or by the program shall be held for laundrying for no longer than one day.(5) Soiled disposable diapers shall be discarded daily.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that soiled diapers were not properly disposed or handled. The container for soiled diapers was not plastic lined.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff with required health and safety trainings

Code: This rule requires the program to ensure the following each staff member has completed and is current with an approved course for age-appropriate first aid and CPR in accordance with rule 5101:2-12-10 of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, at least one person onsite does not have a current age appropriate course in CPR from an approved provider.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff with required health and safety trainings

Code: This rule requires the program to ensure each staff member has completed and is current with an approved course for age-appropriate first aid and CPR in accordance with rule 5101:2-12-10 of the Administrative Code.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, at least one person onsite does not have a current age appropriate course in first aid from an approved provider.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Licensed staff in-service requirement

Code: This rule requires preschool staff members licensed by the department to complete ten annual clock hours, which may be part of the professional development plan in accordance with Chapter 3301-24 of the Administrative Code. Annual completion refers to the school year, from July first to June thirtieth.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, preschool staff licensed by the department did not have evidence of ten in-service hours annually.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff Medical statement

Code: This rule requires a new staff member who meets the criteria to complete a tuberculosis test prior to employment.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, a staff member who meets specific criteria to complete a tuberculosis test did not have the documentation on file.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Non-guilty non-conviction statement

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to have a signed non-guilty non-conviction statement on a prescribed form signed annually.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not or did not have a non-guilty non-conviction statement signed annually.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Orientation training

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to have an orientation training as prescribed by the department completed within thirty days of the individuals start date.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have documentation of the required orientation training prescribed by the department completed within thirty days of the start date.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff minimum requirements

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in the ratio is obligated to have evidence that they have a high school diploma, GED or high school equivalency.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used in ratio did not have documentation of a high school diploma or equivalent on file and available for review.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Annual in-service requirements

Code: This rule requires Annual in-service training be taken from July first to June thirtieth, or every twelve months from the date of hire for staff employed after the school year begins.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, in-service hours were not obtained during the school year as defined by rule from July first through June thirtieth.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Individuals used in ratio

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in the ratio is obligated to have required documentation on file.

Findings: During the inspection and a review of staff files, individuals used in ratio, a student intern, did not have documentation to meet requirements.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180-37:04 Staff Medical statement

Code: This rule requires any individual who may have an assigned schedule with a preschool child (or group) or may be used to count in ratio is obligated to have evidence of a signed medical statement on or before the first day of employment.

Findings: During the inspection and review of staff files, individuals used to count in ratio did not have evidence of a signed medical statement on or before the first day of employment.
