Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition. The program is required to implement and/or follow instructions on the JFS 01236 for a child with a health condition.

<u>Finding</u>: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms, or a medical procedure be performed, or ongoing administration of medication or medical foods at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented



or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number(s) 16 and 27	
below:	

- 1. No plan was on file.
- 2. Child's name was missing.
- 3. Child's date of birth was missing.
- 4. Name of the condition was missing.
- 5. Indication if medication is required was missing.
- 6. Symptoms to watch for were missing.

- 9. Conditions that trigger the need for medication or medical foods were missing.
- 10. Expected results of the medication or medical food were missing.
- 11. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing.
- 12. Activities, foods, environmental conditions to avoid were missing.
- 13. Training instructions were missing.

14. Directions for action to be taken if expected result of medication or medical food does not occur were missing.

- 15. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent was missing.

17. Dated signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.

18. Printed name(s)/Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.

- 19. Dated signature(s) of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.

24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.

25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and

alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.

26. The plan was not implemented.

27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information in that the dose listed did not match the dosage required by the written physician's instructions in that the physician's instruction was for the oral suspension and was listed in milliliters but the medication on site was in tablet form (milligrams).28. The plan was not followed.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Supervision

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing. Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately including responding to the child's basic needs and protecting them from harm.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not being properly supervised as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member in that a child was dropped-off by a parent at the front door and walked through the older toddler room to get to the schoolage classroom without direct supervision.

2. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during outdoor play.

3. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member more than once.

4. Staff were not physically present in the space and near enough to respond and reach the child(ren) immediately.

5. Other: [].

Children must be supervised according to rule and within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to refrain from placing indoor swings, slides, climbers, and climbing apparatus directly over a hard surface.

<u>Finding</u>: The rule requires that indoor swings, slides, climbers, and climbing apparatus shall not be placed over concrete, tile, carpet, or any similarly hard surface. During the inspection, it was determined that the step/slide climber in the infant 2 room was placed on carpet. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 4, 5, 8 below, were in the restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children (pre-k restroom).
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children (older toddler restroom).
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor and floors were unclean (pre-k restroom).

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to administer medication, medical food and topical products for only the time period indicated on the documentation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that inhaler, was administered beyond the time period permitted as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. The medication was on-site to be administered beyond the date indicated by the prescription label in that the prescription label indicated that the medication was to be administered for seven days.

2. The medication, medical food or topical product was administered more than 12 months from the signature on the JFS 01217 or written parent permission.

3. The medication, medical food or topical product was administered after the expiration date on the medication or product.



4. The nonprescription fever/pain-reducing or cough/cold medication that contained codeine or aspirin was administered longer than three consecutive days within a fourteen day period without physician's instructions in box two of the JFS 01217.
