### **Moderate Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a ratio of 1 child care staff member(s) for 10 children was determined to have occurred for the mixed age group (children under 2.5 to schoolage) when the situation in number(s) 1 below occurred:

- 1. A child care staff member stepped out of the room. (child care staff member left room to answer the door and to get items from another classroom)
- 2. A child care staff member had not arrived at work on time.
- 3. Children were present who were not scheduled to be there.
- 4. A child care staff member was unable to work.
- 5. A child was injured in that group.
- 6. A child arrived in the group before a second staff member was scheduled to arrive with the group.

- 7. Two groups were combined, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.
- 8. A child was transitioning to the next older age group, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.
- 9. Ratio was doubled for more than two hours while children were napping.
- 10. Ratio was doubled while children were napping for a group that included at least one infant.
- 11. Ratio was doubled while children were napping and there were not enough staff members in the building to meet staff/child ratio.
- 12. Ratio was doubled in the school age group to allow access to the program, however, the program does not serve only school age children.
- 13. Both child care staff members did not have a working communication device when one staff member left the group to allow access to the school age only program.
- 14. The child care staff member did not return to the group after allowing access to the school age only program.
- 15. Other [ ].

Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide adequate fall surface for the outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the playground did not have adequate fall surface under and around equipment as noted in number(s) 3 below:

- 1. No fall surface;
- 2. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall;
- 3. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall that extended the length of the required fall zone; (large bouncing teeter-totter and bus (that was being used for climbing) did not have a 6ft fall zone. Thick mats only extended 2-2.5 feet from the equipment, then there was very thin rubber mulch over concrete. The concrete was showing through the thin mulch, and would not protect from injury if a child were to fall there)
- 4. Other [ ].

With any equipment designed for climbing, swinging, bouncing, or sliding, that is over twelve inches in height, resilient material, as specified in Appendix A, needs to be added in order to protect children in the event of a fall. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes written verification of the discontinued use of this equipment until corrections are made along with a description of the resilient material added, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Low Risk Non-Compliances**

# Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group. (10 children in attendance but only 5 marked in)

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner (stored in a pile on top of one another). Children's belongings need to be stored in a sanitary manner to prevent the spread of germs. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 9 below, were in the child restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other: Toilet paper was not on a roll dispenser to prevent it from falling onto the floor.

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the sign prohibiting any person from carrying a deadly weapon on the premises.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection it was determined that the sign prohibiting any person, other than law enforcement, from carrying a deadly weapon on the program premises, in accordance with section 2923.1212(A)(8) of the Revised Code, did not meet the rule requirements as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The sign was not posted;
- 2. The sign was posted, but did not contain required information.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all surge protectors and outlets covered.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that 1 surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers (outlet missing faceplate). The program must have safety covers on all electrical outlets, including power strips and surge protectors, which are within the reach of the children. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have play materials accessible and orderly.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that play materials were not accessible/orderly for the following reason(s) as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Play materials were not readily accessible to the children in the mixed age classroom; (manipulatives, and sensory materials had been removed form the classroom)
- 2. Play materials were not arranged in an orderly manner so that children have opportunities to select, remove and replace play materials with minimal assistance during the day in the [ ] classroom.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## **Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

Code: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the small teeter-totter was positioned such that the fall zone for number 1,2 below was not met:

- 1. The fall zone did not extend six feet from the point of furthest extension;
- 2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from fence;
- 3. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment;
- 4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment;
- 5. Other [ ].

The program is required to provide equipment that is safe with adequate fall zones. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide food that does not pose as a choking hazard and is appropriate for the age of the children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the mixed age group including a child under 2.5 was served uncut round meatballs (approx1 1/2-2 inches in size), which posed a choking hazard. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

# **Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to label all cribs.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one crib was not labeled with the child's name, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

Code: The program is required to maintain a staff schedule with coverage of the required health trainings.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined the program did not have at least one child care staff member present/scheduled to be present during all hours of operation with currently valid documentation for the training(s) listed in number(s) 17 below:

- 1. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 2. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had not taken First Aid training
- 3. First Aid trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program.
- 4. First Aid child care staff member scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] did not have verification of completion of First Aid
- 5. CPR child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 6. CPR child care staff scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had not taken CPR training
- 7. CPR trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by children
- 8. CPR child care staff member scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] did not have verification of completion of CPR
- 9. CPR training taken by staff did not include all age groups the program serves
- 10. Communicable Disease child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 11. Communicable Disease child care staff scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had not taken Communicable Disease training
- 12. Communicable Disease trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program
- 13. Communicable Disease child care staff member scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] did not have verification of completion of the full Communicable Disease training
- 14. Child Abuse child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 15. Child Abuse trained child care staff was not in each building used by the program
- 16. Child Abuse child care staff scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had not taken Child Abuse training
- 17. Child Abuse child care staff member scheduled during the hours of open and close did not have verification of completion of the full six-hour Child Abuse training
- 18. Child Abuse child care staff considered to be providing coverage had only the ODJFS prescribed Child Abuse training, which does not meet this rule compliance

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 6. Other: [ ]

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.
