Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a continuous fence or natural barrier that ensured children were not able to leave the playground area. The fence or natural barrier was determined to not present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the program as noted in number(s) 2 and 3 below:

- 1. The fence, natural barrier, or combination of a fence and natural barrier was not continuous.
- 2. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the program.
