<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for [the same group/different groups] on multiple occasions, as noted below:



The ratio determined for the mixed group of Older Toddlers & Preschool group was 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 11 children. Additionally, a ratio of 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 22 children was determined for the combined group of Preschool and School Aged Children. A ratio of 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 16 children was determined for the combined group of Preschool and School Aged Children.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to remove any items listed in rule that are a potential suffocation risk from cribs.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been placed in a crib with an object that created a potential strangulation or suffocation risk, as indicated in number(s) 4 below:

- 1. Bib
- 2. Pacifier clip/ribbon
- 3. Teething jewelry
- 4. Blanket for infant under twelve months old
- 5. Pillow
- 6. Boppie
- 7. Bumper pad
- 8. Clothing stored in the crib
- 9. Diaper bag
- 10. Object or toy strung over the crib in which a child can pull himself up
- 11. Stuffed animal that is large/soft enough to conform to the shape of the child's face

The rule prohibits any item which obstructs child-care staff's visibility or poses a risk of strangulation or suffocation from being placed on or in a crib. Remove the item(s) immediately. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 10. Expected results of the medication or medical food were missing.
- 11. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing.
- 12. Activities, foods, environmental conditions to avoid were missing.
- 13. Training instructions were missing.

14. Directions for action to be taken if expected result of medication or medical food does not occur were missing.

- 15. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent was missing.

17. Dated signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.

18. Printed name(s)/Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.

- 19. Dated signature(s) of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.
- 24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.

25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.

- 26. The plan was not implemented.
- 27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 28. The plan was not followed.

3. The classroom(s) did not provide opportunities for child initiated activities.



A well-balanced program of activities suitable to the developmental levels and abilities of each child in care shall be implemented on a daily basis. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. #### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in number(s) 9 below:

- 1. There was rust exposed;
- 2. There was protruding bolts;
- 3. There were cracks;
- 4. There were holes;
- 5. There was splintering wood;
- 6. There were sharp edges or points;
- 7. There were lead hazards;

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number(s) 1 below:
