- 6. There were thistles with prickers.
- 7. There were bird droppings.
- 8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
- 9. The sandbox was contaminated.
- 10. Other: The ground covering sheet was coming through the mulch which caused a tripping hazard. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
