Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to have an adequate fall surface on the outdoor playground.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the playground did not have adequate fall surface under and around equipment as noted in the following number 1 below:

1. No fall surface for the play set in the playroom inside the home.

Any equipment designed for climbing, swinging, bouncing, or sliding needs a fall zone of protective material resilient under and around the equipment in order to protect children in the event of a fall. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes written verification of the discontinued use of this equipment until corrections are made along with a description of the resilient material added, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in a space used for child care during the program's hours of operation, but no children were present, as noted in number(s)

- 1,5 below:
- 1. A lawn mower.
- 2. A weed trimmer.
- 3. Hedge trimmers.
- 4. A snow blower.
- 5. Other potentially hazardous substance, equipment or machinery: A table saw in the yard leanto with no door.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to anchor and amount gates that are free from entrapment and are the approved style.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the gate(s) used were not safe as noted in number 5 below:

5. Other The gate leading to the laundry room, garage, and bathroom was not latched closed.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule."

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to use fall surface material according to manufacturer's guidelines and provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the fall zone under and around equipment designated for climbing, swinging, balancing and sliding did not meet the requirements as noted in number 1 below:

1. The fall surface material had not been properly distributed, turned over or raked as needed for the playsets on the deck. They were not large enough to cover the entire area.

The program is required to provide adequate fall zones under and around outdoor play equipment at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/26/2025

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Equipment

Code: The program is required to use equipment that is safe and hazard free according to the manufacturer's guidelines. Fans, air conditioners, heat pumps, and space heaters must be inaccessible to children. The program is required to refrain from using trampolines, ball pits and inflatable equipment intended for climbing and bouncing, including but not limited to slides and bounce houses.

Findings: During the inspection, equipment was determined to be unsafe, hazardous to children, or in need of repair as noted in number 16 below:

- 1. Manufacturer's guidelines for the [] were not followed in that [].
- 2. The straps were missing on the [].
- 3. The straps were attached, but were not used on the [].
- 4. The straps were attached and were used, but were not used in a safe manner.
- 5. The equipment had sharp points or corners.
- 6. The equipment had splinters.
- 7. The equipment had protruding nails.
- 8. The equipment had loose or rusty parts.
- 9. The equipment had paint which contains lead or other poisonous materials.
- 10. The equipment had hazardous features.
- 11. A fan was unstable and could easily tip over.
- 12. A fan had openings a finger could enter.
- 13. The pipes from the heat pump felt hot to the touch
- 14. A space heater felt hot to the touch
- 15. The position of a space heater was a tripping hazard
- 16. The air conditioning unit was not enclosed and was accessible to children on the playground.
- 17. A ball pit, trampoline, inflatable bounce house, inflatable slide, inflatable equipment used for climbing and bouncing was used.
- 18. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.



Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/18/2025

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Outdoor Equipment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk and must follow the manufacturer's guidelines for assembling, installing and using the equipment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in the numbers 5, 17 below:

- 5. There was splintering wood on the teeter totter in one spot at the pivot point.
- 17. Other: The slide was becoming separated at the section ends and need to be clamped together underneath to keep children from being pinched.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/26/2025

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-10 Health Training

Code: The program is required to meet the health training requirements.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the CCSM or Substitute CCSM was left alone with children and did not have current valid documentation for training(s) listed in number(s) 10, 14 below:

- 10. Communicable Disease expired training
- 14. Child Abuse expired training

Correct the violation and submit the documentation of current certification with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.



Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in number 13 below:
