Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an outdoor play area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good repair, or other barrier. Although the fence or natural barrier was not meeting the rule requirements, it was determined to not present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground. The fence or gate was not in good repair and/or being used inappropriately as noted in number(s) [3 & 10] below:

- The fencing had missing slat boards.
- 2. The fencing was broken.
- 3. The fencing was loose.
- 4. The fencing was rotting.
- 5. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 6. The gate was locked.
- 7. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 8. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 9. The latch was not engaged to prevent children from opening the gate.
- 10. The gate had no latch.
- 11. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
