# Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.



Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items or conditions which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 11 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 5. Stacked chairs.
- 6. Telephone cords.
- 7. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 8. Diaper bags.
- 9. Television not securely anchored.
- 10. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 11. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 12. Chipping or peeling paint.
- 13. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 14. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 15. A floor surface was unsafe in that [].
- 16. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet.
- 17. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy.
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [ ].
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 22. Other Loose cords for electrical devices were found within reach of children in the living room, play room & kitchen. All loose cords should be wound up and placed out of children's reach.

A Glade Plug-In was found within children's reach in the play room by the play pen. An outlet cover should replace it to ensure children's safety, and the plug-in should be placed out of children's reach.

Toilet brush and plunger were found within children's reach in the bathroom on the floor. These should be placed out of children's reach.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to post the current menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in numbers 1 & 3 below.



- 1. The menu was not posted. (The current menu was not posted.)
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated. (The menu posted was for a past timeframe.)
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

## Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to refrain from using a crib that is assigned to a child for storage.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a crib/playpen, assigned to a child, was used for storage. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule. (Toys and a blanket were being stored in playpen. Provider removed these items onsite at the time of inspection.

#### Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to safely store, prepare, and serve formula, breast milk, and food.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that open containers of ready to serve food and concentrated formula was not stored appropriately as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. The food/formula was not covered;
- 2. The food/formula was not dated;
- 3. The food/formula was not refrigerated according to the manufacturer's instructions;
- 4. The food/formula was not discarded or sent home daily if not used;
- 5. The food/formula was not refrigerated upon arrival;
- 6. The food/formula was not refrigerated immediately after preparation;
- 7. The food/formula was served beyond the expiration date;
- 8. The food/formula was not prepared prior to the manufacturer's instructions;
- 9. The food/formula was not prepared according to the instructions from the infant's physician, physician's assistant or certified nurse practitioner;
- 10. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to provide mattresses in good condition and sheets that are not too large or too small for cribs and playpens.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets, mattresses and/or mattress covers did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number 10 below:

- 1. At least one crib or playpen did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. The mattress was not at least one and one-half inches thick.
- 6. The mattress was not firm.
- 7. There was space between the mattress and the sides and end panels of the crib or playpen which exceeded one and one-half inches.
- 8. The mattress cover was not waterproof.
- 9. The mattress cover was torn.
- 10. Other: The sheet being used in the pack-n-play was not fitted.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to retain and update infant feeding instructions.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review form were not updated, as required by this rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule. (Feeding instructions were not updated for 2 children - K.B. & K.J.)

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program staff is required to have all bottles labeled.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing formula for a particular infant were not labeled with the child's name and date of preparation. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Professional Development

Code: The program staff is required to complete at least six clock hours of training annually.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the Child Care Staff Member (Provider) indicated on the Employee Record Chart did not meet the annual professional development requirement as noted in number 1.

- 1. The child care staff member (Provider) had not completed at least six hours of professional development. (Provider must complete 4.50 hrs. of professional development for year, 07/01/23 06/30/24.
- 2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.
- 3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.
- 4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.
- 5. The substitute(s) had been used more than ninety days annually between July first and June thirtieth and had not completed at least six hours of professional development.
- 6. Other [ ].

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 3, 4, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, & 15 below:

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information (1st day in program was missing for several children.)
- 4. Complete parent information

- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"
