Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-13-18 Group Size and Ratios

Code: The program is required to follow group size requirements.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined 7 children with 2 under two years of age were in the care of one child care staff member which resulted in more than six children/three children under two years of age with only 1 staff on site that met the requirements. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/15/2023

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to refrain from placing blankets in cribs with children under 12 months of age and using bumper pads.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that infant was placed in a crib with a blanket this child is currently on oxytge which created a hazard. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-13-18 Attendance

Code: The program is required to maintain attendance records.

Findings: During the inspection the CCSM could not produce the attendance for the week surrounding the complaint. It was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 1 below:

1. No attendance record was being maintained.
2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
3. The original attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-18 Group Size and Ratios

Code: The program is required to follow ratio requirements.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that children were being supervised by an individual who did not meet the requirements of a child care staff member. At the time of the complaint inspection the resident was supervising the children along with the CCSM. The resident stated that he thought he had met all the requirements to be sub. Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-19 Supervision

Code: The program is required to meet the basic needs of children.

Findings: During the inspection the licensing specialist observed the CCSM sit down at the table. The infant in the crib had been crying for at least 10 minutes. The licensing specialist asked the CCSM to go pick up the child to provide comfort. The assistant child care specialist stopped 2 older toddlers on top of each other in the play area playing too rough. She asked the one child to get off the other and redirected both children. It as determined that the basic needs of a child as noted in the following number(s) 4 below were not met:

1. Assisting children with toileting.
2. Assisting children with hand washing.
3. Assisting children with basic hygiene.
4. Responding appropriately to a child in distress.
5. Assisting a child wiping their nose.
6. Washing a child's face.
7. Assisting a child with tying their shoe(s).
8. Assisting a child in changing their clothes when needed.
9. A child's developmental needs were not met.
10. A child's behavioral needs were not met.
11. Parental preferences, that were not in conflict with a licensing rule, were not followed.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to remove objects from cribs/playpens that could block the child.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been place in a crib or playpen with the following number(s) 2 below which could obstruct a provider or child care staff member's view of the infant:

1. Busy box or other toy attached to the side of the crib or playpen.
2. A blanket hanging over the side of the crib or playpen.
3. Stuffed animal that is not large/soft enough that it could conform to the shape of the child's face.
