Allegation: Complainant alleged that breast milk was given to the wrong child.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant was served another child's breast milk. The program must ensure there is a system in place to serve the correct breast milk to the correct infant. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule. Based on the information obtained during a thorough investigation, the allegation is substantiated.
