Complaint Allegations

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Ratio

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

Allegation: The program is out of ratio.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for different groups on multiple occasions, as noted below:

The ratio determined for the older infant group was 1 Child Care Staff Member for 7 children; young infant group was 2 Child Care Staff Members for 13 children. Additionally, a ratio of 2 Child Care Staff Members for 16 children was determined for the combined group which included children 19 months to 4-years-old.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Allegation: The program is not combining groups according to the rule.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined groups which included children less than two- and one-half years were combined with groups of children two and one half years and older and there were more than 12 children in the center. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is at this time. Please submit a corrective action plan verifying staff have been trained on this rule and that the program is in compliance with this rule.

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Allegation: The program is not combining groups according to the rule.

Findings: During the inspection, group size limitations were not maintained for the group of infants and a combined group of
toddlers and preschoolers as it was determined there were 13 infants and 16 children, which included children 19 months old, grouped together. The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per Child Care Staff
Member. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this
rule.
