Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that children were left unattended and not supervised, in that the provider was sitting out side on the back pourch with the door closed away from the rooms the kids where sleeping in and they were out of sight or hearing. Code: The program staff is required to provide appropriate infant daily care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's infant daily care did not meet the requirements of this rule as noted in number 2 Below:

1. Infants could not safely and comfortably sit, crawl, toddle, or walk and play according to the infant's stage of development;
2. Infants were not removed from the crib, swing, infant seat, exercise seat or other equipment throughout the day for individual attention;
3. Each non-crawling infant was not provided the opportunity for tummy time each day;
