Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cots and Napping

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide enough cots or mats for each child in attendance to be assigned their individual cot/mat. Cots and mats must be firm, resilient, and in good condition.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that cots or mats did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The program did not have enough individually assigned cots and/or mats for each child.
- 2. A child was sleeping at the table. (in the twaddler room, while waiting for lunch)
- 3. Frames were bent/broken.
- 4. Covers were torn.
- 5. Cots were missing bolts.
- 6. Cots were sagging.
- 7. Legs on the cots were broken.
- 8. Cots did not stand at least 3 inches but no more than 18 inches off the floor.
- 9. Cots were not at least 36 inches in length and as long as the child is tall.
- 10. Mats were not at least 1 inch thick and as wide and long as the child assigned.
- 11. Other [].

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number 5, 9 below, was in the boys restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Toilets were out of order. (2 in the boys restroom, 1 in girls restroom)

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in numbers 24, 30, 31 below:

- 1. Item(s) soiled with blood or bodily fluids were not cleaned/sanitized immediately.
- 2. Blankets/sheets were not cleaned weekly, when soiled, or before use by another child.
- 3. Children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner.
- 4. Bottles, bottle caps, nipples and other equipment used for bottle feeding were not cleaned and sanitized in a dishwasher or by washing, rinsing, and boiling for one minute.
- 5. Carpets were not vacuumed weekly or cleaned when soiled.
- 6. Changing table/pad was not sanitized after each use or cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 7. Reusable cloths were not being washed daily or when visibly soiled.
- 8. Cots/Pads/Mats were not cleaned and sanitized before assigning to a different child, when used by a sick child, when soiled or at least every three months.
- 9. Cribs were not cleaned and sanitized monthly, or when soiled, or before use by another child.
- 10. Diaper Receptables were not cleaned and sanitized daily or more frequently as needed to eliminate odor.

- 11. Dishes/Cups/Silverware were not cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 12. Water Containers were not labeled with the child's name, or were not cleaned and sanitized before use again on another day.
- 13. Dividers were not cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 14. Dress up clothes and hats (dramatic play) were not cleaned monthly or when soiled.
- 15. Floors were not cleaned weekly or when soiled.
- 16. The food prep area, including sinks, were not cleaned before and after preparing food (including bottle preparation) or between preparing raw or cooked food.
- 17. Potty chairs were not cleaned after each use, rinsed with water, cleaned and sanitized or contents were not emptied into a toilet.
- 18. Food tables, highchair trays were not cleaned before and after each use.
- 19. Tables used for play were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized daily.
- 20. Toilet bowls were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized weekly.
- 21. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and hand washing sink(s) were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized daily.
- 22. Mouthed toys were not cleaned and sanitized after each child's use.
- 23. Toys, other than those mouthed by children, were not cleaned monthly or when visibly soiled.
- 24. Washable furniture, including fabrics on infant equipment, and cloth chair covers were not cleaned weekly or when soiled. (preschool & Pre-K)
- 25. Upholstered furniture was not steam cleaned when soiled.
- 26. Slip covers were not washed at least every six months or when soiled.
- 27. Wastebaskets/rinse buckets, including lids, were not being emptied daily or cleaned and sanitized when visibly soiled.
- 28. The manufacturer's directions for the cleaning product were not followed.
- 29. The solution used for sanitizing was not a commercial product registered by the United States Environmental Protection Agency as a sanitizer.
- 30. A cloth chair cover was torn, exposing the foam cushion.
- 31. Walls were not cleaned when visibly soiled.

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all staff and children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that handwashing requirements were not followed as listed in numbers 5 (children & staff), 9 (staff) below, as required in rule.

1. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands upon arrival for the day.

- 2. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands prior to departure.
- 3. At least one staff did not wash their hands upon entry into a classroom.
- 4. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after toileting or assisting a child with toileting.
- 5. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after each diaper change or pull-up change.
- 6. At least one staff did not wash their hands after contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids.
- 7. At least one child did not wash their hands after contact with bodily fluids.
- 8. At least one child did not wash their hands after returning inside after outdoor play.
- 9. At least one staff did not wash their hands after cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products.
- 10. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet.
- 11. At least one staff did not wash their hands before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child.
- 12. At least one child did not wash their hands before eating or assisting with food preparation.
- 13. At least one staff did not wash their hands before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication.
- 14. At least one child did not wash their hands after water activities.
- 15. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands when visibly soiled (must use soap and water).
- 16. Other [].

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Emergency Drills

Code: The program is required to complete fire drills, weather drills, and emergency/lockdown drills

appropriately.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed and/or documented for item numbers 1 (for November & December), 3 (last quarter of 2023) below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills.
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September).
- 3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide food that does not pose as a choking hazard and is appropriate for the age of the children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the Roli Poli group was served halved chicken sandwiches on buns which [posed a choking hazard/was not appropriate for their age]. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to label and store bottles with breast milk following the requirements in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that breast milk provided by the parent was not stored appropriately as noted in number 1 (date bottle was prepared) below:

- 1. Not labeled with infant's name, date pumped, and date bottle was prepared;
- 2. Not immediately refrigerated or frozen;
- 3. Stored at room temperature longer than eight hours;
- 4. Stored at the program for more than five days after it was expressed;
- 5. Stored longer than two weeks in the freezer compartment of the refrigerator;
- 6. Stored longer than six months in the refrigerator/freezer;
- 7. Stored longer than twelve months in the deep freezer;
- 8. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in numbers 2, 3 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.
