Allegation: Chemicals (Downy Febreze aerosol, Lysol, Clorox spray cleaner and Bleach) in reach and accessible to children at the time of inspection. Items were found on the kitchen counter and top of small freezer located by refrigerator. This non-compliance is a 3-point MRNC that has been reported to the county agency to issue the non-compliance and CAP.

**Determination**: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it as noted in number(s) 1, 2 & 9 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children on the kitchen counter and top of small freezer located by the refrigerator.
